A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CONTRACT AMENDMENT NUMBER SEVEN TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KASBERG, PATRICK & ASSOCIATES, LP OF TEMPLE, TEXAS FOR DESIGN PHASE SERVICES RELATING TO THE LITTLE RIVER ROAD EXPANSION PROJECT IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$127,150; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

Whereas, this item will allow for the execution of Contract Amendment No. 7 to the professional services agreement with Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP (KPA) of Temple, Texas for design phase services relating to the construction of the Little River Road Expansion Project - these additional services are needed to update existing plans for the remaining portion of Little River Road;

Whereas, improvements extend from Barnhardt Road to US 190 (Loop 363) and include the design of two traffic signals on Little River Road - the existing signal at US 190 will be revised to accommodate left turn movements going north along Little River Road onto US 190, and one new signal will be added at Blackland Road (the portion south of the Temple Independent School District tract);

Whereas, on November 7, 2019, Council authorized a professional services agreement with KPA for the Blackland Road Extension Project with a value of \$678,485 - since then, six contract amendments have been executed;

Whereas, Contract Amendment No. 1 included road- and utility-related improvements to Little River Road with an associated professional services cost of \$316,880 - Contract Amendment No. 2 added State Highway 95 turn lane design phase services at a cost of \$88,500;

Whereas, Contract Amendment No. 3 included drainage-related improvements with an associated professional services cost of \$2,150 - Contract Amendment No. 4, for construction phase professional consulting services for the construction of Blackland Road Extension, added an additional \$315,300;

Whereas, Contract Amendment No. 5 added design services for revisions needed to the existing State Highway 95 turn lane design and Contract Amendment No. 6 added wastewater extensions to the Lower Knob Creek Wastewater Trunk Extension portion of the project, while relocating associated flood plain management efforts over to the Barnhardt Road Improvements design contract - with the execution of this contract amendment, the revised value of the professional services agreement is estimated at \$1,591,445;

Whereas, these design phase services will run concurrently with the ongoing design and construction of the Lower Knob Creek Wastewater Trunk portion of the project and the Little River Road Project will be bid and constructed separately - the cost associated with the proposed Little River Road improvements is estimated at \$8,500,000;

Whereas, these design phase services, with an additional 28-calendar-day duration, carry this contract through to an estimated design completion date of February 28, 2025;

Whereas, Staff recommends Council authorize Contract Amendment No. 7 to the professional services agreement with KPA for design phase services relating to the Little River Road Expansion Project in the estimated amount of \$127,150;

Whereas, funding for Contract Amendment No. 7 to the professional services agreement with KPA in the estimated amount of \$127,150 is available in Account No. 365-3400-531-6998, Project No. 103104 - funding for construction of the Little River Road Expansion is planned for as part of the Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Improvement Program; and

Whereas, the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1: Findings. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Part 2: The City Council authorizes Contract Amendment No. 7 to the professional services agreement with Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP of Temple, Texas for design phase services relating to the Little River Road Expansion Project in the estimated amount of \$127,150, and authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, after approval as to form by the City Attorney’s Office, to execute any necessary documents.

Part 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
