ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution authorizing the creation of the Central Texas Regional 9-1-1 Emergency Communications District.

BACKGROUND: Chapter 772, Subchapter H, of the Texas Health and Safety Code, cited as the Regional Emergency Communications District Act (the “act”), provides the creation of a Regional Emergency Communications District. The act applies to a state planning region established under Chapter 391 of the Texas Local Government Code with a population of under 1.5 million, composed of counties and municipalities that operate a 9-1-1 system solely through a regional planning commission. The Act requires that the governing bodies of each participating county and municipality in the region adopt a resolution approving the creation of the Regional Emergency Communications District. As of May 25, 1989, the City of Temple exclusively receives 9-1-1 system services operated through the Central Texas Council of Governments, a regional planning commission and supports the creation of the 9-1-1 Emergency Communications District.
