ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution ratifying a grant application and authorizing the City Manager to accept funding from the Texas Commission on the Arts - Arts Respond Performance Support program in an amount not to exceed \$212.

BACKGROUND: This program provides professional artist fees to schools, libraries, and nonprofit organizations for hiring an artist from the Texas Commission on the Art's Texas Touring Roster to do a performance or workshop. These non-competitive applications are funded based on a percentage of contracted fees up to 50%. The library will seek reimbursement for fees associated with a bilingual TCA touring roster performer, Sue Young, for our second-annual Dia Celebration.
