A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE CENTRAL TEXAS REGIONAL 9-1-1 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

Whereas, Chapter 772, Subchapter H of the Texas Health and Safety Code, cited as the Regional Emergency Communications District Act (the “Act”), provides the creation of a Regional Emergency Communications District;

Whereas, the Act applies to a state planning region established under Chapter 391 of the Texas Local Government Code with a population of under 1.5 million, composed of counties and municipalities that operate a 9-1-1 system solely through a regional planning commission;

Whereas, the Act requires that the governing bodies of each participating county and municipality in the region adopt a resolution approving the creation of the Regional Emergency Communications District (the “District”);

Whereas, as of May 25, 1989, the City of Temple exclusively receives 9-1-1 system services operated through the Central Texas Council of Governments, a regional planning commission;

Whereas, Staff recommends Council authorize the creation of the Central Texas Regional 9-1-1 Emergency Communications District; and

Whereas, the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1: Findings. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Part 2: The City Council authorizes the creation of the Central Texas Regional 9-1-1 Emergency Communications District.

Part 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
