Dear Mr. Kolacki:

I am writing to formally submit Change Order #3 for the 24th Street Overpass and Pedestrian Improvements Project, which involves utilizing the existing outside concrete rails for the BNSF required fencing over the BNSF right-of-way and painting the rails with anti-graffiti paint.

The BNSF construction service team required any demolition of the existing concrete barrier rail to incorporate steel plates on the rail infrastructure below. With the area in the right-of-way being the BNSF fueling yard, this would not be a practice construction method to complete the project. Due to these requirements the project will utilize the existing concrete barrier and attach the required fencing to the existing concrete rail. Anti-graffiti paint will be applied to all rails on the project with the City of Temple picking the color of the paint. The unit prices for this change order are consistent with typical costs for this type of work.

We are in agreement with the proposal to utilize the existing concrete barrier rail for fencing over the BNSF right-of-way.. The effect on the project is a deduct in the amount of \$96,205.00.

We have reviewed Change Order #3 and recommend it be processed and executed with respect to the Patin Construction, LLC's contract for the above referenced project.
