**ITEM DESCRIPTION:** Consider adopting a resolution authorizing an Interlocal Agreement between Fort Cavazos Fire and Emergency services and the Temple Fire Department for the provision of mutual aid by both fire departments at various locations.

**BACKGROUND:** This Interlocal Agreement will allow Temple Fire Department to provide and receive mutual aid fire services with Fort Cavazos Fire and Emergency services at locations throughout the City of Temple and Fort Cavazos Military installation for fire, haz-mat and special rescue incidents. City firefighters will perform fire, haz-mat and special rescue services and respond with appropriate/designated equipment and will receive reciprocal mutual aid from Fort Cavazos Fire and Emergency services. All parties shall bear their own costs in the fulfillment of this agreement, to include personnel, equipment, insurance, and liability.
