A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON THE ARTS - ARTS RESPOND PERFORMANCE SUPPORT PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$212; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

**Whereas,** the Texas Commission on the Arts (TCA) - Arts Respond Performance Support Program provides professional artist fees to schools, libraries, and nonprofit organizations for hiring an artist from the TCA's Texas Touring Roster to do a performance or workshop;

**Whereas,** these non-competitive applications are funded based on a percentage of contracted fees up to 50 percent - the Temple Public Library will seek reimbursement for fees associated with a bilingual TCA touring roster performer, Sue Young, for the City's second annual Dia Celebration;

**Whereas,** Staff recommends Council ratify the submission of a grant application as well as authorize the City Manager to accept funding from the TCA - Arts Respond Performance Support Program in an amount not to exceed \$212;

**Whereas,** if the grant awarded is accepted, the City will receive \$212 in grant funds to be used towards the purchase of programming from Sue Young, estimated at \$425; and

**Whereas,** the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Part 1: Findings.** All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

**Part 2:** The City Council ratifies the submission of a grant application and authorizes the City Manager to accept funding from the Texas Commission on the Arts - Arts Respond Performance Support Program in an amount not to exceed \$212.

**Part 3:** The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, after approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office, to execute any necessary documents.

**Part 4:** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
