ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution authorizing an Interlocal Agreement with the Temple Independent School District to provide standby emergency medical services at varsity home football games for the 2024 football season.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, the City of Temple ("City") will enter into an interlocal agreement with Temple Independent School District ("TISD") for Temple Fire and Rescue ("TFR") to provide standby emergency medical services at Varsity home football games for the 2024 football season. The City will provide two TFR personnel, at the minimum level of one certified paramedic and one certified emergency medical technician ("EMT") at each home football game, beginning 30 minutes prior to the start of the game through the duration of each game. It is estimated this will require approximately three (3) hours of staff time per TFR personnel assigned, per game. TISD will reimburse the City for each of TFR personnel's overtime as follows:

Base Hourly Rate:

For a paramedic assigned to provide standby medical services, reimbursement will be at an hourly rate not to exceed \$100.00;

For an EMT assigned to provide standby medical services, reimbursement will be at an hourly rate not to exceed \$95.00;

Employee Benefits:

Charges for employee benefits will be calculated for each TFR personnel assigned and added to the base hourly rate.

This agreement will commence August 2, 2024, and will terminate after the last home football game of the 2024 varsity football season. This agreement will be extended in the event of TISD hosting any

playoff games. There are currently seven home varsity games on TISD's 2024 schedule: August 22nd, August 30th, September 6th, September 20th, October 11th, October 25th, and November 7th.

FISCAL IMPACT: Based on the estimated number of hours worked during each of the seven home games, it is estimated that the City could be reimbursed by TISD approximately \$4,095 for overtime plus benefits associated with the overtime during FY 2024 and FY 2025.
