ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution authorizing contract amendment #23 to the professional services agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for construction phase services associated with Phase 4C of the Bird Creek Interceptor Project in the estimated amount of \$61,442.

BACKGROUND: Approval of this item will allow for the execution of contract amendment #23 to the professional services agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for construction phase services required for the construction of Phase 4C of the Bird Creek Interceptor Project. On December 23, 2024, change order #3 to the construction contract with Phase 4C contractor D Guerra was approved extending contract time 45 days. This change order #3 time extension allows for completion of construction, testing and completion of punch list items. These contract amendment #23 additional services are needed to extend expired contract time and construction phase services through project completion. As outlined in the attached engineer's proposal letter, the budget for onsite construction observation services was expended the second week of October 2024 due to underestimating time required onsite in contract amendment #22 negotiations.

In 2007, Council authorized a professional services agreement with Carter Burgess, Inc., now Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. (Jacobs), for engineering services related to the Bird Creek Interceptor Project. This project, phased and implemented over several years, is targeted toward reducing overflows and rehabilitating infrastructure, ultimately providing for increased capacity within the wastewater collection system. Phase 1, 2, 3, 4A, 4B and 5 of this project have been completed. Phase 4C is the final phase with construction beginning at the intersection of Bird Creek and Daniels Drive extending to just south of the HK Dodgen Loop 363. See the attached project map. This contract amendment #23 extends Jacobs construction phase services through project completion. Total authorized professional fees for Jacobs related to this project are currently \$4,948,898.40. With the execution of this contract amendment #23 in the amount of \$61,442, the revised value of the professional services agreement will be \$5,352,574.40.

The proposed timeline for these construction phase services extends to February 07, 2025.
