A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A FISCAL YEAR 2025 TEMPLE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM – HERITAGE & ARTS AGREEMENT WITH THE CULTURAL ACTIVITIES CENTER FOR ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMMING TO BECOME AN ARTS DESTINATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

**Whereas,** the City of Temple supports the efforts of many public service agencies throughout the community through its Temple Community Partnership Program – Heritage & Arts Grant Program;

**Whereas,** the Heritage & Arts Program was developed to focus on programs or services that promote the arts, tourism, and the City’s rich heritage - eligible programs will increase the availability and variety of visual and performing arts, museum exhibits/programs, and other tourism-related activities;

**Whereas,** Staff recommends Council authorize a Fiscal Year 2025 Temple Community Partnership Program – Heritage & Arts Agreement with the Cultural Activities Center for enhancement programming to become an arts destination in an amount not to exceed \$75,000;

**Whereas,** funding for this agreement with the Cultural Activities Center in the amount of \$75,000 is available in Account No. 240-4600-551-2681; and

**Whereas,** the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Part 1: Findings.** All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

**Part 2:** The City Council authorizes a Fiscal Year 2025 Temple Community Partnership Program – Heritage & Arts Agreement with the Cultural Activities Center for enhancement programming to become an arts destination in an amount not to exceed \$75,000, and authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, after approval as to form by the City Attorney’s Office, to execute any necessary documents.

**Part 3:** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
