A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FROM SIDDONS-MARTIN EMERGENCY GROUP, LLC OF HOUSTON, TEXAS IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$175,000, FOR A TOTAL OF \$375,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 2025; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

Whereas, this item will allow for the authorization for the continued purchase of maintenance and repair services of emergency vehicles and fire apparatus during Fiscal Year 2025 from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC (Siddons-Martin) of Houston, Texas;

Whereas, on September 19, 2024, Council authorized the estimated expenditure of \$200,000 with Siddons-Martin for maintenance and repair services - Staff is requesting an increase of \$175,000 to the anticipated expenditure, bringing the total to \$375,000 for Fiscal Year 2025;

Whereas, Siddons-Martin has been awarded BuyBoard Contract No. 746-24, which Staff is recommending using - contracts awarded by BuyBoard have been competitively procured and meet the statutory procurement requirements for Texas municipalities;

Whereas, Staff recommends Council authorize the expenditure of additional funds for emergency vehicle maintenance and repair services from Siddons-Martin in the estimated amount of \$175,000, for a total of \$375,000 in Fiscal Year 2025;

Whereas, funding for the additional \$175,000 for emergency vehicle maintenance and repair services is primarily available in Account No. 110-2230-522-2333; and

Whereas, the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1: Findings. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Part 2: The City Council authorizes the expenditure of additional funds for emergency vehicle maintenance and repair services from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC of Houston, Texas in the estimated amount of \$175,000, for a total of \$375,000 in Fiscal Year 2025, and authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, after approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office, to execute any necessary documents.

Part 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
