ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution ratifying an agreement with Technology for Education of Hewitt for installation of a public announcement system and announcement scheduling module at the Temple Public Library in the estimated amount of \$50,479.

BACKGROUND: On February 15, 2024, the City administratively executed an agreement with Technology for Education (TFE) to install a new public announcement (PA) system at the Temple Public Library in the amount of \$49,970. Staff is requesting ratification of this agreement and the addition of an announcement scheduling module in the estimated amount of \$509, for a total contract value of \$50,479. The addition of this module gives staff the ability to schedule pre-recorded messages without any IT involvement or presence.

TFE has been awarded contract #230105 by The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS), which Staff utilized to procure this purchase. Contracts awarded by TIPS have been competitively procured and meet the statutory procurement requirements for Texas municipalities.
