<u>ITEM DESCRIPTION:</u> Consider adopting a resolution authorizing the acquisition of two rights of way and two public utility easements necessary for the construction of the South Pea Ridge Road Expansion Project in an estimated amount of \$45,000.

BACKGROUND: The City is in the design phase for roadway improvements to South Pea Ridge Road from Westwood Hills Boulevard to the proposed realignment of Poison Oak Road. Improvements include expanded pavement sections, pedestrian facilities, and drainage conveyance. The design requires the acquisition of right of way, utility easements, and drainage easements from thirteen (13) properties.

Appraisals have been conducted on all the properties and offers have been made to property owners based on the appraisals. No relocations of citizens or businesses are anticipated with this project. With the assistance of Stateside Right of Services, the City has reached an agreement with two property owners for rights of way and public utility easements.
