A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF TWO DECOMMISSIONED TEMPLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PATROL VEHICLES TO THE CITY OF DAWSON (TX) POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

Whereas, the City of Temple is decommissioning two patrol vehicles in accordance with City fleet service life standards - these vehicles have been stripped of Temple Police Department identifying markings, radios, and video systems per normal decommissioning protocol;

Whereas, the City of Dawson, Texas requests these vehicles be transferred to Dawson Police Department to fill an immediate need - the Dawson Police Department experienced mechanical failure of two patrol vehicles and have an immediate need of replacement to fulfill their public safety mission;

Whereas, the City of Temple typically places decommissioned police patrol vehicles up for public auction through GovDeals and historically the City has received approximately \$1,500-\$2,000 per vehicle;

Whereas, the City of Temple and City of Dawson will enter into an Interlocal Agreement establishing each City's rights and responsibilities related to the vehicle transfer before the transfer takes place;

Whereas, Staff recommends Council authorize the City Manager to transfer decommissioned Temple Police Department Patrol vehicles to the City of Dawson (TX) Police Department;

Whereas, estimated revenue in the amount of \$4,000 from public auction will not be realized; and

Whereas, the City Council has considered the matter and deems it in the public interest to authorize this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Part 1: Findings. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, and they are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Part 2: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to transfer decommissioned Temple Police Department Patrol vehicles to the City of Dawson (TX) Police Department and authorizes

the City Manager, or her designee, after approval as to form by the City Attorney's office, to execute any documents that may be necessary.

Part 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.
