<u>ITEM DESCRIPTION:</u> Consider adopting a resolution authorizing a professional services agreement with Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP of Temple for design work to rehabilitate the pedestrian bridge near Kegley Road and FM 2305 as well as design the future expansion of the Pepper Creek Trail under the bridge headed south along Pepper Creek and along FM 2305 to connect to existing sidewalks in the amount of \$239,400.

BACKGROUND: Approval of this item will allow for the execution of a professional services agreement with Kasberg, Patrick & Associates, LP (KPA) for design work to rehabilitate the pedestrian bridge near Kegley Road and FM 2305 as well as design the future expansion of the Pepper Creek Trail to Kegley Road and the connection along FM 2305 to existing sidewalk infrastructure. This is accomplished by tying into the existing trail on the north side of the pedestrian bridge, going under FM 2305 and exiting out on the south side.

Pepper Creek Trail has been a very popular trail since the first day it opened. With the continued growth of the City, in addition to the opening of Crossroad Regional Park, this trail will continue to grow in use and be a major trail to connect multiple neighborhoods together. The updated 2020 Parks and Trails Master Plan also lists this trail under the priority listing section.

As identified in the attached engineer's proposal, KPA will be providing the following professional services:

In accordance with Texas Government Code Chapter 2254, Request for Qualifications (RFQ) #13-14-20 was issued to procure professional engineering services. KPA was selected from the City's prequalified list of engineering firms based on their demonstrated competence and qualifications to perform similar projects.

The engineer's preliminary opinion of probable construction cost for this project is \$2,750,000. Design of this project is expected to be complete within eight (8) months from the notice to proceed.
