**ITEM DESCRIPTION:** Consider adopting a resolution authorizing change order #1 to the construction contract with Matous Construction, Ltd, of Belton, for the construction of the Water Treatment Plant Membrane Facility Expansion in the amount of \$649,760.29.

**BACKGROUND:** Approval of this item will allow for the execution of change order #1 to the construction contract with Matous Construction, Ltd. for the construction of the Water Treatment Plant Membrane Facility Expansion.

As outlined in the attached engineer’s letter of recommendation related to this change order, the proposed project scope changes includes replacing an existing HVAC unit, additional isolation valves between clearwells and high service pump station, slurry filling and extra depth needed for the foundation piers, and replacing two (2) traveling screens at the Raw Water Pump Station. There is also a credit to substitute the fiberglass chemical bulk storage tanks with HDPE tanks.

On March 4, 2021, Council authorized a construction contract with Matous Construction for this project in the amount of \$44,608,188.70. With the execution of this change order, the revised value of the construction contract will be \$45,257,948.99, a 1.46% increase to the original contract amount.

This change order will add 0 days to the construction contract and the final completion date will remain April 19, 2023.
